

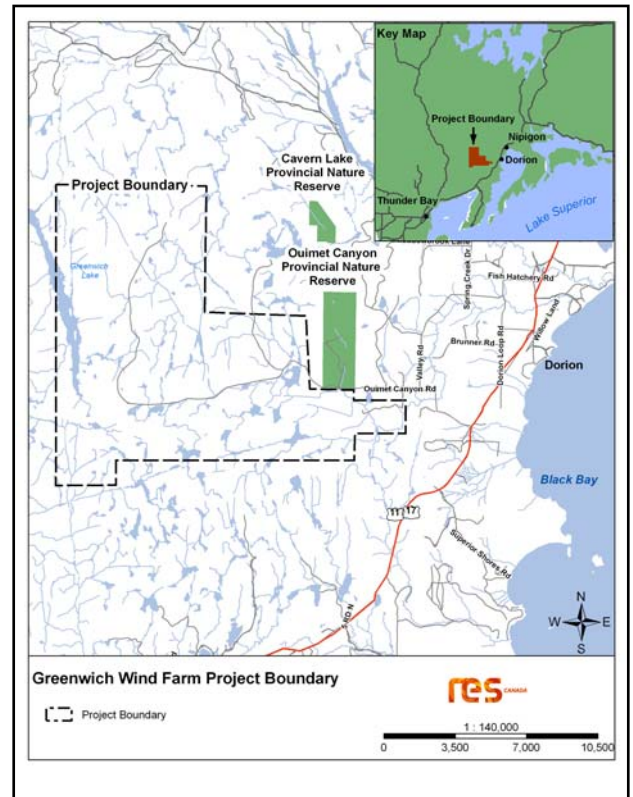
# Notice of Completion of Environmental Screening Greenwich Wind Farm

Renewable Energy Systems Canada, Inc. (RES) is the proponent for the Greenwich Wind Farm, which will generate electricity in Northern Ontario, approximately 75 kilometers northeast of Thunder Bay near the community of Dorion (see map). The wind farm is expected to consist of 72 turbines in total and will generate 166 MW of electricity when fully built. The first phase of the project will consist of 43 turbines and will generate 99 MW of electricity.

The Project is subject to the Environmental Screening Process (Category B) under the Ontario Ministry of the Environment's "Guide to Environmental Assessment Requirements for Electricity Projects" (March 2001). The Notice of Study Commencement was issued on October 17, 2007.

This is notice to the public and key stakeholders that RES has completed the Environmental Screening Process for the Greenwich Wind Farm and has determined that there are no significant environmental impacts (including the natural and social environment) associated with the Project. A copy of the Draft Environmental Screening Report ("ESR") was available for public review from June 9 – July 8, 2009. Comments collected during this period assisted in completing the ESR. Beginning July 13, 2009, the ESR and supporting documents will be available for public review on the Project website ([www.greenwichwindfarm.com](http://www.greenwichwindfarm.com)) and in hard copy at the following location:

This Notice of Completion triggers a 30 day review period during which interested persons may submit comments on the ESR. If after reviewing the ESR and supporting documents, an interested person has outstanding environmental concerns about the Project, that person should raise such concerns with RES as soon as possible at either of the addresses below. If RES and the concerned person are unable to resolve the matter, the concerned person can make a written request to the Director of the Environmental Assessment and Approvals Branch of the Ministry of Environment to elevate the Project to an individual Environmental Assessment under the *Environmental Assessment Act*. Elevation requests must be made in accordance with the provisions set out in the Ministry of the Environment's Environmental Screening Process for electricity projects. Elevation requests must be received by the Director, Environmental Assessment and Approvals Branch, Ministry of the Environment, 12A Floor, 2 St. Clair Avenue West, Toronto, Ontario, M4V 1P5 by August 11, 2009 with copies to RES and its environmental consultant identified below. Please note that the previous publication of this notice stated that the end date of the review period is August 10, 2009. The correct date is August 11, 2009.
